



### **FOREWORD**

Welcome to Little Loveney Hall, Wakes Colne. The meeting here today, the 2nd rounds of the British Sidecar-Cross Championship and the British Four-Stroke Championship.

We have here today the top sidecar crews in the country and the cream of the country's top 4 stroke stars.

1995 Sidecar Champion, Chris Etheridge with new passenger, Mike Turner started the defence of the title in style at the opening round at Frome by winning all three races and must start favourites here today. A 21 point lead over his rivals has emerged. All very tight between 2nd place and 5th place in the series standings just five points. Good to see Shaun Mallows back again after taking a rest, same chair-man, Jason Peters, as before. Mallows/Peters are just ahead in points of Colin Philpott/Gary Withers with Trevor Hollister/ Paul Chapman right behind by only 1 point.

Very much a local pairing of Peter Clark/John Chambers will be looking to secure a good points haul today to keep the pressure on his Centre adversary, Mallows.

Northerners, Stuart Brown/David Keane can on a good day pose a threat to the leaders but did not score well at Frome. Welsh crew of Andy May/Andy Toon despite not scoring high points at Frome are within striking distance of the top 5.

8th spot in the points table are Midlanders, John Grahame/Simon Morgan. 9th spot goes to Jimmy Mogey/George Roberts. Making up the top ten Steve Kellow/ Peter Chant, this pair like the two crews above them only scored points in two races at Frome.

Making the long trek from Ireland, Raymond and Robert Harron and Geoff Ingram/Colin Addis.

Is this the year of a challenge for Perry Leask's title? Could it be Brian Wheeler, Russ Jarman or Simon Wyse? Leask (Husqvarna) after the opening round is 11 points down on the leader Brian Wheeler (KTM). Russ Jarman (KTM) shares the third spot with Simon Wyse (CCM) both on 43 points. Way down from the leader, Paul Irwin (Husaberg) takes the 5th spot and John Deacon (KTM) the 6th spot.

7th to 10th places only 5 points seperates Simon Dearing (Husky), Jason Fountain (Husaberg), Dean Lane (Husaberg) and Stacey Harman (Husqvarna).


