## FOREWORD

Good afternoon and may we welcome you here once again to Little Loveney Hall. The scene here today is the Strand Glass International Team Sidecar Moto-Cross. The Halstead Club are most grateful to Strand Glass for sponsoring this Event here today.

This meeting here today marks the start of the International Sidecar Moto-Cross Season for 1975 in this country and what a way to start with four teams from overseas and one from Great Britain to compete for a Team Trophy. The team with the lowest aggregate points total will be awarded the Trophy.

In 1974 we had only two teams from the Continent but today we can double that by having four teams, Holland, Sweden, Denmark and Switzerland, plus a Great Britain team.

A look now at the teams; from Great Britain we have the top three drivers in last year's British Sidecar Drivers' Championship, Nick Thompson, John Turner and Mick Holloway a very formidable team.

Holland will be represented by Ton van Heugten, Fans van Heugten and Willi van de Laan. It was this driver who was the most successful driver here last year. Denmark are perhaps the most under-rated team here today but nevertheless should give a good account of themselves, ably led by Ebbe Sorensen.

From Sweden Goran Anderberg, Ingemar Andersson and Alf Ake Jansson. The Swiss team will be headed by Emil Bollhalder and Herbert Bohren.

The National Sidecar supporting races have attracted almost all of the top drivers in this country. This afternoon sees the return of Dave Bickers to the Chair Brigade with Rex Garrod in the chair. Dave will be riding a 636 cc CCM. Also, we have Kim Logan, Dave Fox and Doug Fox, Rowing Brothers, Paul Cooper and Terry Good just to mention a few.

Solo supporting aces are such names as John Banks, Stuart Nunn, Andy Robertson, Norman Barrow, Rob Taylor and the Suzuki team of Bryan Wade, Terry Dyer, Billy Aldridge.

An unusual feature here today will be the Braintree Carnival Band who will entertain you before the meeting starts and during the interval and we feel sure that you will enjoy their display.

The Halstead Club are most grateful to Mr. & Mrs. D. Crooks for the use of the circuit and also to Mr. & Mrs. P. Durston for the land for the car parking area and to all Marshalls from various E. Centre Clubs.

Thank you for your support here today and may we hope that you have had a good afternoon's racing and may we see you here again on Sunday, 7th September when we shall present the Final Round of the British Sidecar Drivers' Championships. Safe journey home.
