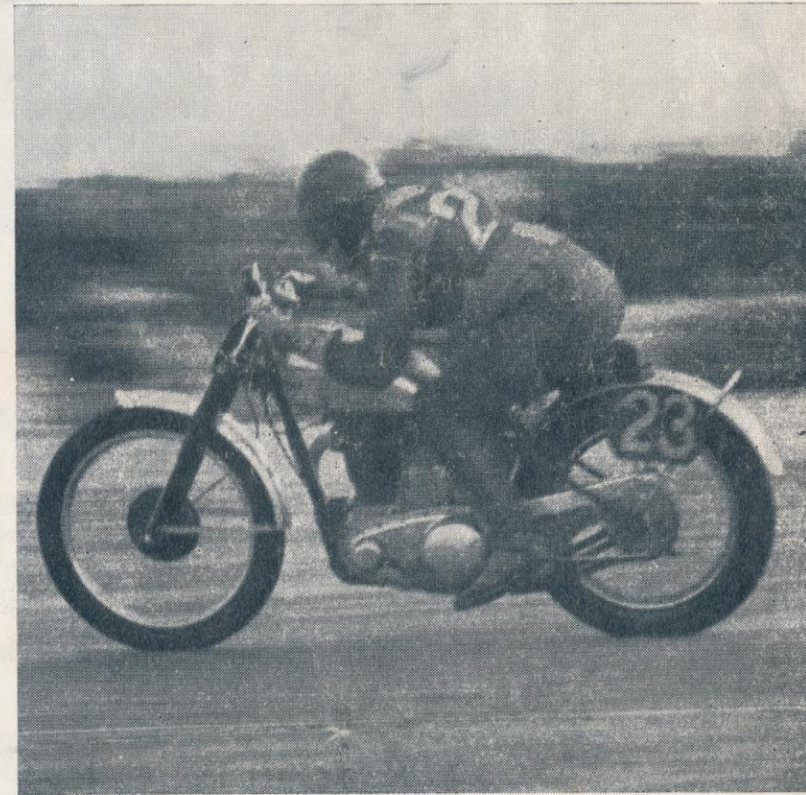

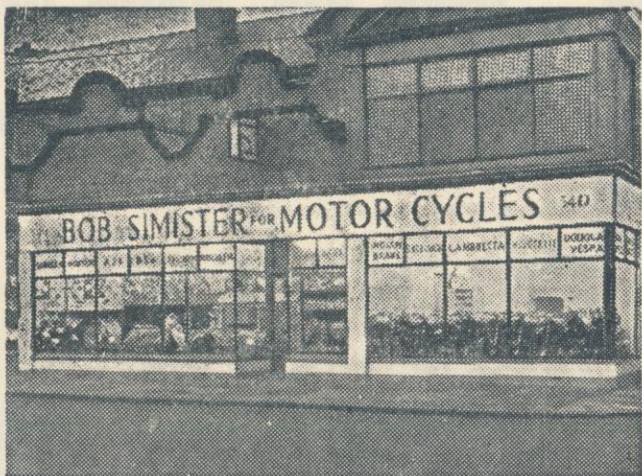

## WALLASEY GOLD CUP SAND RACES.

OVER the years we have seen a gradual change in the pattern of the Wallasey Sand Races. In the early days with the dearth of Road Racing Circuits the Wallasey Sands provided a good alternative to Road Racing proper. Consequently, most of the machines were modern Road Racing Bikes and of course in those days there was a very strong resemblance to the touring Motorcycle. Nowadays the typical Road Racing machine is rather removed from its touring counterpart and there are quite a number of venues where "ironmongery" of this description can be aired.

One would feel under these circumstances that Sand Racing should be showing a decline but in point of fact this Meeting has the largest entry that we have seen for over four years with nearly 100 machines entered. The bikes in general are not modern Road Racing machines by any stretch of the imagination. The oldest machine is older than the youngest rider and there are also a number of other machines that can be classed as, if not vintage, then possibly, obsolete. We know from experience that this will in no way detract from the racing and in view of the large entry we should see a particularly good day's sport.

The Wirral 100 Motor Club would like to express their thanks to the Wallasey Corporation and the Chief Constable and the Police for their kind help and co-operation in enabling us to run this Meeting.

We should also like to thank the Spectators who have bought a programme as the only income from the Meeting is by the sale of programmes.
