John Poppitt

John Poppitt, who died last weekend, first became involved with the AMCA in 1974 after the Macclesfield club joined the Association, he worked in Macclesfield and couple of riders asked him to help out as the Group Secretary and in 1975 he was elected as the AMCA's Northern Secretary, with Peter Stones the Co-ordinator.

At this time, the AMCA had 2 Midland Group of Clubs (East & West) and the North consisted of Bolton, Chester, Derby Sporting, Glossop, High Peak, Lancaster, Macclesfield, Manchester and North Staffs.

Meetings were held at the Old Millstone Inn, Macclesfield.

In 1976, John was largely responsible for starting the AMCA Northern Motocross League with the Clubs and also agreed to act as the Groups Press Officer, sending reports and results to Motor Cycle News (No T&MX in those days).

Events in the North at this time had practice at 12.00 with racing from 2.00 till 6.00 and entries of around 150 riders.

In 1976, John took over as the Co-ordinator and represented the Group at the AMCA Executive Committee meetings.

More Clubs joined including Tameside, Chorley and Preston, and the first club in Yorkshire at Bradford (Calderdale).

The Following year the Group meetings moved to Bolton and by the end of the year, plans were made to split the Group into two - Northern and North Midlands with John looking after the latter and Group meetings returning to Macclesfield.

The Group then had Chester, High Peak, Manchester, Macclesfield, North Staffs and Derby Sporting moved back from the East Midlands.

Several more clubs were to join and John attended every event sitting in the Race Control taking late entries, sorting out the paperwork and sometimes lap scoring and even commentating as well as working out the results.

During a period of short time working he travelled down to the AMCA Office at Walsall and helped out. He rarely missed an Executive meeting or the AGM's and 5 days before he died, he attended the Group meeting, taking the chair. He had suffered a mild stroke a few weeks previous which stopped him attending events.

Many 100's of riders must have met and spoken to him and he was the longest serving AMCA Co-ordinator, who was later elected as an AMCA Director when the AMCA became a Limited Company.

He attended an early Inter Group Team event at the Brownhills track and was like a fish out of water not having his regular job in the Race Control, making sure all the paperwork and the event went smoothly.

The AMCA's expansion in the 60's and 70's from one Group in the Midlands to as many as 20 throughout the country, took a lot of effort and John Poppitt played a big part in the AMCA's growth in the North. A quiet chap who did not make a lot of fuss but was always there when it mattered. I spent many hours at meetings with him and was glad I saw him at what turned out to be his last meeting.

To his family and friends on behalf of so many people, we do appreciate his help and thank you for the time he gave to the AMCA and the sport.

He joined the Macclesfield club in 1974, when it first started, riding as a Junior Solo rider, having rode ACU previously.

A regular sidecar driver and chairman of the Macclesfield Club, as well as a Director of the AMCA, Bernard is well known throughout the AMCA and all members and friends will be wishing him a speedy recovery.
