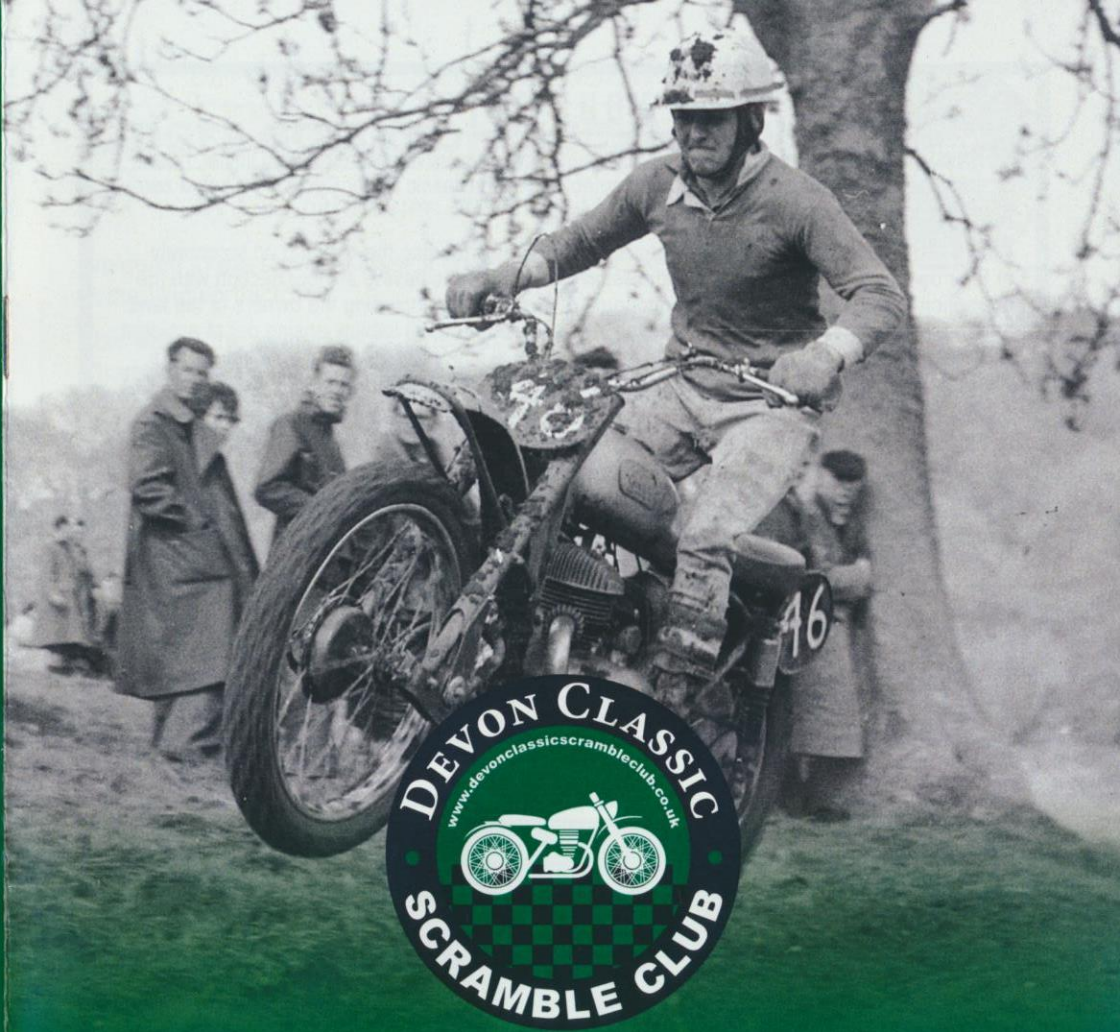

Welcome to the Devon Classics first scramble of the year, at the Widworthy track.

This will be the tenth Badger Goss Trophy event, in celebration of this British Champion and much loved local legend.

Bryan (Badger) Goss was born in 1940. His love of motorbikes began early. He entered his first scramble shortly after his sixteenth birthday. Soon after, inspired by another Yetminster lad, grass track and speedway star Lew Coffin, Badger tried his hand at this alternative discipline. However, a broken leg convinced him he should stick to scrambles. In 1959, his early promise led to a works Cotton ride. Then, in the early 1960s, Greeves took him on - a moment Badger described as "a dream come true". Thus began the heyday of Badger's career. Later in the 60s he moved to

Husqvarna. His accolades included victories in the 1966 Trophee des Nations, the BBC Grandstand Trophy and, in 1970, the British 500cc Championship.

Badger was a local legend, and was always a good friend to The Devon Classic Motorcycle Club.

Another character we will be thinking of today is Malc "Jock" Bell. Malc was a supporter of many of the classic scrambles clubs. There won't be many riders here who haven't, at some time, been towed back to the paddock by Malc on his trusty red quad, after breaking down out on the track.

We will also be missing Garry Scaysbrook, who sadly died this winter. He has been a supporter of the club for many years, most recently as our Chief Marshal.

Today, as well as competing for the Badger Goss trophies, donated by Badger himself, Devon Classic Club riders will be gathering points towards the club championship trophies that are given at the annual presentation.

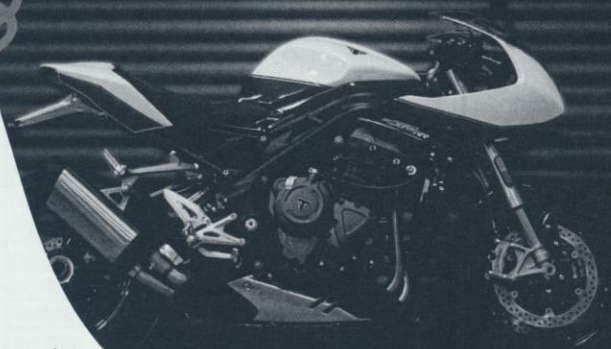
