We're very pleased to be running again at this beautiful Wroughton venue, and our thanks must go to the Royal Navy for their kindness in allowing us to use the facilities here.


Sponsor of the European Funny Car Championship, the second round of which you are witnessing today, is Tor Line, best known for their excellent passenger ferry service to


We hope you enjoy the drag racing here today — please drive carefully on your way home and we hope to see you all again at our next meeting.














Hazze Fromm's Capri Funny Car has 8500 cc Garlits Dodge engine

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

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HOW A DRAG RACE WORKS

Like cricket you will enjoy drag racing more if you know what is going on. Here is the basic make-up of a drag race meeting. For greater detail purchase an NDRC rule book.

A drag race comprises an initial period of PRACTICE and QUALIFYING, followed by the main racing programme called the ELIMINATIONS.

One of the great attractions of drag racing is the wide variety and classes of race vehicles. Accordingly, there are several divisions of competition. The four basic "types" of drag racing machines are:

DRAGSTER * COMPETITION ALTERED * STREET * MOTORCYCLE

These are sub-divided by a system of classes into specific divisions of eliminations, on a capacity to weight basis.

TOP FUEL DRAGSTER (A/D) Supercharged, using nitro-methane fuel, with a total factored capacity minimum of 610 cu. in.

TOP DRAGSTER (T/D) 3.99 lbs/cu. in. or less.

SENIOR DRAGSTER (S/D) 4.00 to 5.49 lbs/cu. in. (side valve engined cars with a minimum of 2.5 lbs./cu. in. are included in S/D).

MIDDLE DRAGSTER (M/D) 5.50 to 6.99 lbs/cu. in.

JUNIOR DRAGSTER (J/D) 7.00 or more lbs/cu. in.

FUNNY CAR (A/FC) Full-bodied cars using nitro-methane, supercharged and with minimum of 610 cu. in.

TOP COMPETITION (T/C) Bodied full-competition cars not meeting A/FC and with 2.99lbs/cu. in. or less.

SENIOR COMPETITION (S/C) 3.00 to 4.49 lbs/cu. in.

MIDDLE COMPETITION (M/C) 4.50 to 6.99 lbs/cu. in.

JUNIOR COMPETITION (J/C) 7.00 lbs/cu. in. or more.

PRO-STOCK (PRO) Ultimate stock-based street cars to the Pro-Stock formula.

SUPER STREET (A/M or A/SA) Originally a production car but unlimited modification away from stock condition (modified) or complete engine change (street altered), both 6.00 to 8.49 lbs/cu. in.

TOP STREET (T/S or T/SA) 8.50 to 10.99 lbs/cu. in.

SENIOR STREET (S/S or S/SA) 11.00 to 14.99 lbs/cu. in.

MIDDLE STREET (M/S or M/SA) 15.00 to 19.99 lbs/cu. in. JUNIOR STREET (J/S or J/SA) 20.00 or more lbs/cu. in.

As you can see the prefix letter indicates sub-division and the suffix the main division of elimination (e.g. S/C 12 is a Senior Competition (Altered) with race number 12). All the above eliminations are raced on an equal start of "head-up" basis. Stock Production cars are run on a handicap basis. The handicaps are determined by the difference between Class records. Normally, two eliminations are raced, made up from the quickest cars from the 14 Production classes that exist. These classes range from A/Production (A/P) at 8.00 to 9.99 lbs/b.h.p. to N/Production (N/P) at 55.00 lbs/b.h.p. or more. Note that DIN b.h.p. to weight determines Class in Production and not capacity to weight.

For 1975 a new elimination called Pro-Competition has been instated, incorporating T/D and T/C. In this elimination supercharged cars are restricted to methanol or petrol, whilst unblown cars run any percentage of nitro-methane. (Any supercharged nitro-methane buring T/C wishing to remain on fuel

must therefore run in A/FC.)

It should be noted that in calculating capacity/weight ratios that premiums are added for use of

superchargers, nitro-methane fuel, etc. (See NDRC rule book).

Returning to the format of race, the eliminations fields are made up from elapsed times (ET) recorded during the practice/qualifying session. For example: Top Street, say 8 quickest cars make up the elimination from an 11 car entry. Numbers of entries permitting, elimination fields are increased by factors of 8, i.e. 16, 32, etc. So runs made in practice/qualifying session mean a lot, especially if you are in the "bump spot" — number 8 position!

Finally, because of the different factors affecting motorcycles the eliminations are determined purely by elapsed time, i.e. Top Bike elimination is formed from the quickest eight bikes regardless of

capacity.

MOTOR CYCLE CLASSES: All competing vehicles will be divided into the following capacity classes within their appropriate divisions:

This capacity classification letter will prefix the division letter which will prefix the competitors number. e.g. F/S101 indicates a 300cc Street Solo – number 101.

DIVISIONS: There will be two divisions for all competing vehicles:

'S' - Street Solo

'C' - Competition Solo

'S' - STREET: Open for all motorcycles which are street legal, taxed and insured. Proof of both these latter two must be produced.

'C' - COMPETITION: Open for all motorcycles designed and constructed for out-and-out racing. Elimination racing will be constituted as follows with eligibility determined by elapsed times recorded during the qualifying timed runs held prior to the elimination:

MOTOR CYCLE SUB-DIVISIONS OF ELIMINATIONS

TOP COMPETITION: Consisting of the quickest eight qualifiers.

SENIOR: Consisting of the next eight qualifiers.
MIDDLE: Consisting of the next eight qualifiers.

JUNIOR: Consisting of the next eight wualifiers with no motorcycle over Class E.

TOP STREET: Quickest eight qualifiers. SENIOR STREET: Next fastest eight.

Further elimination brackets in Street Motorcycle will be considered as entries demand.

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
