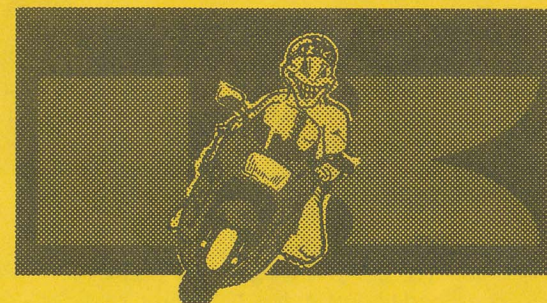

WROUGHTON ** SUNDAY 21st MAY

Ding...Ding...Round Three.....and what a great on circuit scrap it should be if rounds one and two are anything to go by. After one at Keevil, our fastest circuit, followed by two at Pembrey our slowest, comes Wroughton, a track with a bit of both. Fast bits for the those with power, balanced out by the sweeping curves for those with the skill to exploit their machines handling to the fullest.

The 1.4 mile Wroughton circuit was used for the first time last year and came in for almost universal praise from the riders. Each of the 8 lap finals make for frantic action. The high speed sprint into turn one shows up the bravest on the brakes, illustrated last year by Sean Noice and Ian Wiltshire, with neither man wanting to back off...the inevitable happened...contact...firstly with each other...then with the tarmac. Both, Sean and Ian, walked away from the incident unscathed, and undeterred are both entered for this meeting.

This years Club Championship carries £1000, put up by The Gloucester Kawasaki Centre and that means that good points scoring rides throughout the season are vitally important. This is good news for the spectators as it means that we can almost guarantee that all the championships "big names" will be present, and battling hard in their respective classes.

Looking at the individual events now, the 250cc class has been the property of Southampton's, Gavin Lee, so far with two emphatic wins on his TZ Yamaha. Gavin, a former NGMCC Club Champion, and top British SuperCup competitor may have had it all his own way until now, but Bristol's Mark Chapman, the Pembrey Man-of-the-Meeting, is improving fast on this his first full season on a pure-race TZ Yamaha, after starting his racing career on production based machines, and looks set for another good head to head with Gavin, as well as Stonehouse based Neil Richardson. Neil, is another well capable of victory and he too uses one of the well proven TZ 250cc V-Twin Yamahas. Bucking the TZ trend is Thatcham's Nigel Lambourne, a double winner here last season he now has his hands on an Ex-Japanese championship RS 250 Honda, and after a dreadful round one at Keevil which saw the motor seize big-time he bounced back at Pembrey with a strong fourth place, on what is after all still a very unfamiliar machine to him. Nigels, 1994 Wroughton track knowledge could well pay dividends in this highly competitive class. Look out too for Peasemore's Paul Smith, Eastleigh's Chris Sansome and Bristol's Ian Wiltshire.

Eastleigh's Gino Palmier, currently heads the 600cc classifications on his CBR 600 Honda, no mean feat, because the 600 event is one of the toughest classes this year. There are probably a dozen of the forty strong grid well capable of taking the victory. Looking to steal back the top spot will be Corsham's Neil Sutton, after taking the win first time out at Keevil, he had to sit on the side-lines at Pembrey and watch his points advantage disappear due to breaking several fingers in a racing incident mid April. So challenging Palmier, will be Sutton, on the London Camera Exchange CBR Honda, Bristol's Jeremy Box, Ipsden's Pete McRobbie, Didcot's Paul Thomas, and Melksham's Darrell Higgins on the DTR TZ 350, the list just goes on and on. Father and Son racers, Keith and Kevin Stoddart, are also among the challengers, I don't think, Son, Kevin will be showing any respect for his elders here!, both will be gunning for the win.

The big 750cc and 1100cc Superbikes will be, to say the least, a bit quick around here covering the 1.4 miles in something in the region of 55 seconds (if conditions are right), it will be an awesome sight as these powerful machines are literally man-handled through the twisty back section of the circuit. Topping the entry we have Ex-Marlboro Clubmans Champion Paul Willis on his GSX 1100R Suzuki, Nick Williamson on the ZXR 750 Kawasaki, Rod Veck, Current Club Champion with his CBR 900 Fireblade, Jon Walter on his now fully sorted YZF 750 Yamaha and World Championship Phase One Endurance Team Boss Russell Benney, on another high-spec ZXR Kawasaki. All the top manufacturers are represented...let battle commence.

A good line up is assured in the Single Cylinder class, where 125's are pitted against machines of 650cc and over, by the way, any one who thinks that the 125cc bikes will be uncompetitive racing against those with motors up to 5 times bigger should watch out for Cullompton's Shane Selway on the RS 125 Honda. Shane, beat all-comers at Pembrey last time out...not just once but twice. Cheltenham's Roy Perry, Single Cylinder lap record holder here at Wroughton on the 680 Yamaha will head the challengers along with, Taunton's Wil Bennett, on the 500 MX Honda, Falmouth's Les Dinham on a 680 Tigcraft, and Morton-in-Marsh rider Dave Pither who uses a 496 Petty.

Dave Pither, is also likely to be a front runner in the Classic Bike race, which evokes memories of a time when it was only British Bikes on the grid and every-one wore black leathers. It will be tough to pick a winner from today's line up, but along with Pither there is Phil Davenport (750 Trident), Gary Winton (750 Triumph), Colin Bevan (750 BSA), Terence Moring (750 Triumph), Philip Ball (850 Triumph), David Smith (250 Yamaha), Ian Hardisty (250 Ducati) and Len Clutterbuck (498 Seeley). This is just about the best Classic Bike grid you will find, they are the pick of the British scene.

As well as all the above there will be races for Production machines, Formula 400's, and Sidecars. A great days racing is guaranteed.....dare you miss it?.
