RIDING IN THE PADDOCK

Attention is drawn to the serious consequences which could arise following an accident caused by unauthorised riding in the paddock. Children are often allowed to ride machines in the mistaken belief that because a race paddock is on private ground and outside the jurisdiction of the Road Traffic Act, no insurance is necessary. It cannot be stressed too strongly that the LIABILITY FOR A SUBSTANTIAL CLAIM COULD REST WITH THE OWNER OF THE VEHICLE AND THE DRIVER (OR THE PARENTS IN THE CASE OF A MINOR). The Union's Insurers will quite legitimately repudiate any claim on them for damages arising out of any accident caused by an unauthorised driver.
