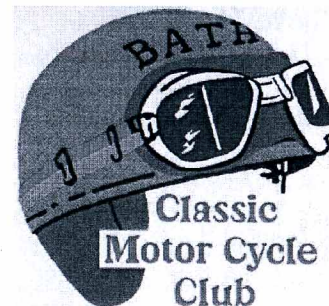

2022 AMCA/CDB BRITISH CLASSIC MOTOCROSS CHAMPIONSHIP

Happy new Championship year to you all. We hope that you have all been keeping well over the winter period and are all fit and ready for the new season.

As many of you will have read over the past few months, we have been working hard on enhancing and improving the AMCA/Classic Dirt Bike British Classic Motocross Championship. Back in November 2021 a new championship committee was formed, made up of riders, organisers and supporters of our great sport, since then, we have met several times both over "Zoom" and face-to-face in very productive meetings mapping out our vision for the British Championship. In December we launched an online survey which many of you kindly completed which has also helped us form our direction.

So, what has changed for 2022? Well as riders of this year's series you will know we have introduced registration for 2022, we hope by introducing registration this ensures that everyone has the opportunity to register for the series. As part of the registration process, we also introduced a registration charge of £20. We will be using these registration fees to plough back into the championship with awards, merchandise, end of year awards evening and much, much more.

As a committee we had an aspiration that we would have many more riders wanting to compete in the 2022 Championship and so far, registrations have proved this to be true. The result of this is that we will be splitting the championship races, here at Bath all Pre60 and Pre65 riders will be competing together and the Pre68 and Pre74 riders will compete together in a separate race. Each category will have 2 championship races so that means 4 great championship races to watch! All races in the series this year will be 15 minutes + 1 Lap ensuring that we have great length races for our championship riders and hopefully giving supporters and spectators an opportunity to experience amazing battles.

As we will still have some mixed categories this year, championship riders will be asked to ensure their background plate colours on their classic machines are according to the AMCA Classic Rulebook, as a reminder these are.

Pre 60 – Black Numbers on White Plates

Pre 65 – White Numbers on Black Plates

Pre 68 – White Numbers on Blue Plates

Pre 74 (Over 250cc) – White Numbers on Red Plates

Pre 75 (Up-To 250cc) – White Numbers on Green Plates

At the end of each Championship event in 2022 we will be acknowledging the achievements of the championship riders with awards and prizes. Here today at Bath the presentation will take place on the podium at the end of the event, so please stop around to cheer for your favourite competitor!

As with any new venture we are keen to get sponsors on-board, we are grateful so far to EnPro and NEB who have signed up to supporting the championship in 2022. If you would like to be part of this exciting new adventure, please come and see us today or drop us a message.

As you can see, we have been trying hard to enhance the series this year, but we know we have much more to do. We have quite a few ideas and to test that these work for future championship series we have decided to run a "test" event this year. The Devon Classic Club have kindly offered to host this event on their date of the 11th of September at the superb Smeatharpe venue. This British Jubilee Championship Scramble will be run with age related British Classic Championship solo classes and we hope to also incorporate a Support Solo Championship class, Sidecars and a Classic Scrambles Club Team Trophy race! Keep a close eye out on social media, AMCA website and our own website for further information about this exciting event.

We are also looking to organise an end of year Championship presentation evening on Saturday 5th November, so keep this date free in your diary and further information about the evening will be posted on our socials in due course.
